

ORDINANCE NO. O-6-16

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 2 OF THE CITY CODE, ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION", ARTICLE II, ENTITLED "MUNICIPAL-COUNTY RELATIONS", SECTION 2-6 THEREOF, ENTITLED "EXEMPTION FROM MONTGOMERY COUNTY LEGISLATION AND REGULATIONS WITHIN THE CITY" AS BEING APPLICABLE AND ENFORCEABLE WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of Gaithersburg, in public meeting assembled, that Chapter 2-6 of the City Code entitled "Exemption from Montgomery County Legislation and Regulations Within the City", is hereby enacted with amendments to read as follows:

Sec. 2-6. - Exemption from Montgomery County legislation and regulations within the city.

It is hereby ordained by the mayor and city council of the City of Gaithersburg, Maryland, that pursuant to the authority granted by ~~Article 23A, Section 2B(a), Section 4-111~~ of the Local Government Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, ~~as amended from time-to-time, as enacted by Chapter 398 of the Laws of Maryland, 1983,~~ and further pursuant to Chapter 33 of the Laws of Montgomery County, 1984, as codified in Chapter 2, Section 2-96 of the Montgomery County Code (1972 edition, as amended), as may hereafter from time to time be amended, the City of Gaithersburg, Maryland, is hereby declared exempt from any and all legislation and regulations pertaining hereto, heretofore or hereafter enacted by Montgomery County, Maryland, relating to any subject or matter upon which the mayor and city council of the city, or the City of Gaithersburg, as a municipal corporation, has been heretofore or is hereafter granted legislative authority, with the following exceptions which shall hereafter be applicable to and within the City of Gaithersburg, Maryland:


